

Primary Responsibilities

- Provide real time Travel related information to the travelling public that helps them make informed travel decisions
- Perform Traffic Incident Management related duties designed to clear the roadway as quickly as possible (< 90 min) in accordance with Florida's Open Roads policy
- Coordinate Road Ranger service assistance to incident scenes such as crashes, disabled vehicles, debris removal and any other unplanned instances which impact traffic flow
- Work with area maintaining agencies to optimize SW Florida's roadway network
- Ensure that ITS devices are operating correctly
- Assist in Emergency Operations







SunGuide Software

- Through the SunGuide software we do the following
- a) Activate Dynamic Message Signs (DMS) messages
- b) Post messages to the Florida 511 system
- c) Send Notification emails
- d) Dispatch Road Rangers
- e) Arrive and Depart responders
- f) Respond to WWD alerts

Single Lane Blockage – All signs within 20 miles Full Closure – All signs within 50 miles As needed signs (below)








Performance Measures

- Open Roads Time- First Responder on Scene to All Travel Lanes Cleared
- Roadway Clearance Duration- Initial Travel Lane Closure to All Travel Lanes Cleared
- Incident Clearance Duration Initial Notification Time to Last Responder Departed
