As you know, Traffic incident Management (TIM) and Quick Clearance (QC) Laws, policies, and procedures are essential to improved incident management and safety—and the successful implementation of a Quick Clearance program is a tremendous benefit to the movement of individuals and freight throughout the nation. The I-95 Corridor Coalition, as a result of an earlier study on Quick Clearance and Move-it Best Practices, has developed a TIM/QC Toolkit and a Responder Workshop to present these best practices and lessons learned.
