Introductions: The team members provided their name and agency in the chat box for introductions and meeting attendance record.

Brandy Boccuti informed the team that the virtual TIM Team meeting is being provided to the TIM Team stakeholders to allow the opportunity to connect safely during this COVID19 time.

Additionally, the virtual meeting guidelines were reviewed with the team to help the meeting run more smoothly.

Agency News:

Road Rangers

The team was informed that the Road Rangers are currently hiring and also preparing for the holiday season. The Road Ranger performance measures were also provided to the team.

Andy Beymer, LEL, informed the team of the upcoming Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Campaign during the holiday season.

Update on TIM Initiatives:

Brandy Boccuti informed the team about the success of the recent National Traffic Incident management (SHRP2) Training that took place virtually on January 27, 2022. The training certified over 50 first responders from the FDOT District One TIM Team.

The training was developed *BY RESPONDERS - FOR RESPONDERS*, with the objective that nationally, responders acquire a common set of core competencies that promote a shared understanding of the requirements for achieving the safety of responders and motorists, quick response, and effective communications at traffic incident scenes.

The National Traffic Incident Management Responder Training is endorsed by the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the International Association of Fire Chiefs, and the National Volunteer Fire Council.

Participants received a National TIM Responder Training certificate from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) after completing the training.

Some of the topics include:

- Notification and Scene Size-Up
- Safe Vehicle Positioning
- Command Responsibilities
- Traffic Management
- Clearance and Termination

Luis Hernandez, D1 SWIFT SunGuide, presented to the team on the TMC performance measures and Electric Vehicle Incident Response – Road Ranger Guidelines.

Tom Arsenault, Metric Engineering, provided a training session on Wrong Way Drivers (WWD). The Florida Department of Transportation has two ways of being notified of a WWD. Traffic Vision and Blink Link.

When a WWD is detected, several activations occur.

- Emails are sent to the on-duty Operators.
- Those contain a screen shot which includes the location and time.
- An event is started, and a Message is posted on DMS "Wrong Way Driver Reported Use Caution". Radius of 15 Miles in each direction.
- If the WWD is verified the TMC notifies FHP.

Tom Arsenault, Metric Engineering, provided the Road Ranger performance statistics.

After Action Reviews (AAR) provide agencies with actionable intel on an incident or event that can be used for improved strategies for future occurrences, demonstrating the benefit of quick clearance practices and improve cross-agency coordination and communication.

AARs were performed on the following recent major incidents:

November 17, 2021 Wrong Way Driver I-75 Northbound Exit 195 Laurel Rd.



Lessons Learned:

- Initial Notification 11:31:28
- Video is available 11:32:13
- DMS Boards Activated 11:46:04
- Self-Corrected 11:48:04

November 5, 2021 Southbound I-75 Near Exit 210 Multi Vehicle Crash



Lessons Learned:

- Involved several vehicle and injuries.
- RISC was activated and later canceled and Advanced handles incident.
- MOT was set up correctly

- The roadway was not completely closed and right lane and shoulder the public was able to use.
- Incident Duration 139 Minutes

October 22, 2021 Southbound I-75 Near Exit 205 Multi Vehicle Crash



<u>essons Learned:</u> Full closure for

crash investigation.

- Good example of communication among responders as they knew this would be a lengthy closure and worked to divert traffic.
- 6-7 vehicles involved in incident
- Diversion route activated
- Bay-Life required
- Incident Duration 254 Minutes
