June 13, 2023 Meeting Minutes

<u>Call to Order</u>: The Sarasota-Manatee TIM Team meeting was held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 at 1:30 PM at the Manatee County Public Safety Center, 2101 47th Terrace East, Bradenton, FL 34203. Tom Arsenault and Brandy Boccuti facilitated the meeting.

# **Agency News:**

#### Road Rangers

The team was informed that the Road Rangers trucks will have red and white lights on the rear of their vehicles.

Ray Mikol, D1 SWIFT SunGuide, informed the team of the performance measures for 2023.

Additionally, the team was informed that incidents have increased significantly in District One.

Law Enforcement informed the team of the upcoming Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Campaign for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday.

Additionally, the team was informed that the recent Clicket or Ticket campaign was extremely successful. Lastly, FHP informed the team that their staff is depleted as have been dispatched to the Florida Keys and Texas.

The Traffic Management Center informed the team they are preparing for the hurricane season. Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) maintenance improvements were identified from lessons learned from Hurricane Irma and will have been implemented.

#### **Update on TIM Initiatives:**

Tom Arsenault, Metric Engineering, reminded the team about the purpose of the TIM Meeting.

 TIM is the coordinated detection, response to and removal of traffic incidents as quickly and safely as possible. TIM is a coordinated effort among multiple agencies.

- The primary purpose of TIM is to reduce the duration and impact of incidents as well as to improve the safety of motorists and most importantly our incident responders.
- The TIM Meeting is to help prop up the communication, coordination, and collaboration among our incident responders.

Uriel Garcia, DeAngelo Contracting Services (DCS), presented to the team the 2023 Emergency Shoulder Use (ESU) and Hurricane preparation.

ESU is Florida's innovative strategy to increase traffic capacity during hurricane evacuations on key corridors within the state.

- Uses existing paved shoulders
- Replaces former One-Way Plans, also known as contraflow and reverse laning.
- First used during Hurricane Irma in 2017
