

# Heartland Counties Traffic Incident Management Team July 2, 2024 Meeting Minutes

<u>Call to Order</u>: The Heartland County TIM Team meeting was held virtually on Tuesday, July 2, 2024, 1:00 PM. Tom Arsenault and Brandy Boccuti facilitated the meeting.

# Other Agency News

Robbie Brown, FDOT, reminded the responders of the importance of communication with the Traffic Management Center (TMC) when on-scene.

Ray Mikol, HNTB, informed the team they are posting detour routes on the DMS signs if there is a set route and/or a preferred route if there is a full closer. The TMC requests that the first responders communicate any detours, and they will update their notification system.

Tim Web, Field Operations Supervisor, for Piece River Operations Heartland, introduced himself to the team. Mr. Web's responsibilities include filtering all phone calls that come through dispatch for LaBelle, Sebring, and Piece River.

Paul Keller, FDOT, informed the team that Aim Asset and Maintenance will be the Asset Maintenance Contractor in Okeechobee and recommended they be added to the Heartland Team.

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The team brought up their concern with the increase in oil bucket waste and other debris that has been abandoned on the side of the highways. It was recommended that if there is a specific location where the incidents seem to occur to inform law enforcement and/or Tom Arsenault and he can communicate with law enforcement in regard to patrolling the area.

## Update on TIM Initiatives:

Tom Arsenault, Metric Engineering, reminded the team about the purpose of the TIM Meeting.

- TIM is the coordinated detection, response to and removal of traffic incidents as quickly and safely as possible. TIM is a coordinated effort among multiple agencies.
- The primary purpose of TIM is to reduce the duration and impact of incidents as well as to improve the safety of motorists and most importantly our incident responders.
- The TIM Meeting is to help prop up the communication, coordination, and collaboration among our incident responders.




